- TMA Bob Holzer reported that the Municipal Authority had a special meeting to discuss the need for additional funding for the East/West Elm Street Sewer Line repair project. The Authority out of pocket in the 2021 budget was \$23,000 and \$30,466 is needed, resulting in a shortfall of \$7,466. The authority voted to

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commit to the additional funds needed to move ahead with the project and receive funding through the ARC.
