
No members of the public were in attendance.

Pursuant to Ordinance #294, Terry Patterson, the owner of 102 May Street is seeking approval to remove a portion of the sidewalk adjacent to the subject property. Mr. Patterson would like to remove 92' of the sidewalk along May Street from the corner of the lot (River St & May St) to the end of the house. Most of the sidewalk has been in disrepair and is broken up by tree roots. A portion of the sidewalk had to be removed to repair a broken water line. The applicant is asserting the cost to replace 92' of the sidewalk is prohibitive.

After discussion, Tom Mohny moved to approve the Application of Terry Patterson to remove a portion of sidewalk measuring 92' in length by 4' wide adjacent to and along 102 May Street, 2nd by Denny O'Toole, motion carried.
