Public Comment: Members of the public inquired as to recent developments relating to the Ambulance Service. It was discussed that the two paid employees are no longer employed through the ambulance service. Judy McDaid stated a special meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 3, 2021 @ 7:00 at the Ambulance building relating to personnel matters. Members of the public didn't understand how the ambulance board operated. It was explained that the ambulance service is an entity (corporation) separate and apart from the Borough and all other municipalities. Each municipality appoints a delegate to represent them on the board and each municipality provides an annual contribution to help fund the service. The Borough nor any other municipality directly operates the service. Any other questions have to be addressed to the ambulance board at its meetings. Cathy Blum expressed interest in being appointed as the Ambulance delete for the Borough.


